
Pastor Mike Lyle will kickoff a new sermon series, **New Beginnings**, that

explores the fascinating story of Ruth. Reminding us how to hear and receive God's blessing in the coming year.


On Sunday, January 22, join us for a special evening you will not want to miss with worship and dinner.

We will be dedicating this service to the glory of God in its new home, and celebrating this significant moment together with a fantastic meal in Warren Hall following worship.






