Music Notes: In celebration of Black History Month, we proudly feature contributions to the sacred music repertoire by Black composers during the month of February. Today's prelude and postlude are from Adolphus Hailstork's (b. 1941) collection "Four Spirituals." Hailstork's works blend musical ideas from both the African American and European traditions. He presently serves as Professor of Music at Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Virginia. We also offer today a spiritual arrangement by Henry Thacker ("Harry") Burleigh (1866-1949). Burleigh was the first African-American composer acclaimed for his concert art songs as well as for his adaptations of African-American spirituals. Burleigh made black music available to classically trained musicians by introducing them to spirituals and arranging them in a more classical form.
